


Romans: A Study of Chapter 15-16

Question 6

What does the phrase "the God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet" mean for your current battles?

(Rom 16:20)

Question 7

Looking back at the whole book, how has your understanding of God's "righteousness" changed?
