

Week 2: Dead to Sin, Alive in Christ (Romans 6)

Essential Question: If grace covers sin, why is it impossible for a believer to continue living a lifestyle of sin?

- **Follow-up Questions:**

1. How does baptism symbolize our death and resurrection with Jesus?
2. What does it mean to "count yourselves dead to sin" (v. 11) in a practical, moment-by-moment sense?
3. How can you practically "offer the parts of your body" to God as instruments of righteousness?
4. Paul says we are no longer "under the law" but "under grace." How does grace motivate obedience differently than the law does?
5. Compare the "wages of sin" with the "gift of God." How does the word "wages" change the meaning?
6. What "shameful things" did you used to serve, and what is the benefit of your new "slavery" to God?
7. How do you respond to someone who says, "I can sin because God will forgive me"?
