

Week 7: The Remnant and the Grafted In (Romans 11)

Essential Question: How should God's faithfulness to Israel throughout history encourage our confidence in His promises to us?

- **Follow-up Questions:**

1. What does the "remnant" (vv. 1–6) teach us about God's grace in dark times?
2. Explain the analogy of the olive tree. Who are the branches, and who is the root?
3. Paul warns Gentile believers not to be "arrogant." How might Christians today be tempted toward spiritual pride?
4. What is the "mystery" Paul reveals regarding Israel's "hardening"?
5. How does God use the inclusion of Gentiles to "make Israel envious"?
6. How does the doxology (vv. 33–36) serve as the perfect response to the theology of chapters 1–11?
7. How does "the depth of the riches of the wisdom of God" comfort you when you don't understand your circumstances?
