A Message from Our journey through Lent should make us revisit and renew our relationship with Jesus. From this side of the cross we seldom think of Jesus as being fully human. But He was! For me, the most telling example of His humanness was one of the statements He made as He hung on the cross. "I thirst". No doubt His mouth was dry and His human need for water caused Him to call out.



There was a soldier standing at the cross who took action when Jesus said, "I thirst". The soldier dipped a sponge in sour wine and with a hyssop stick touch it to the lips of Jesus. A very human action, a compassionate action, an immediate action. All of us who know this account of the passion of Jesus Christ have imagined being there on that dark Friday afternoon. Perhaps you thought of yourself as just being an observer or one of the disciples who were hiding off in the distance fearing for your life. Or maybe you were one of the two thieves who were hanging beside Jesus. Or Mary watching your son being killed before your eyes.

A young girl was asked who she might be if she were at the event. She said the soldier. She wanted to be the one who touched the lips of Jesus. The one who was filled with compassion and did something about it!

The human Jesus did thirst, but the divine Jesus does thirst. As He hung on the cross His thirst was for the renewal of all humankind, including you and me. That is really what we need in this season of Lent. A renewal of our relationship with Jesus, a renewal of our faith in Him and a renewal of our commitment to His world.

We touch the lips of Jesus when we visit the sick. We touch the lips of Jesus when we console the bereaved. We touch the lips of Jesus when we seek justice in this world. We touch the lips of Jesus when we offer forgiveness to those who have wronged us.

During this season of Lent may you add to this list. A new and personal way of touching the lips of Jesus. And together as the body of Christ may we seek to touch the lips of Jesus.

The 2024 per capita apportionment for Valencia Presbyterian Church is \$4,066.40. The amount is based on our 2022 membership of 92 at \$44.20 per member. The distribution is as follows: \$32.00 to Beaver-Butler Presbytery, \$2.40 to the Synod of the Trinity, and \$9.80 to the General Assembly for a total of \$44.20.

To be fair to all the churches of our presbytery and to meet our covenantal obligation to all governing councils, we encourage each member to pay their portion of \$44.20.


